Notes For Absence If your child does miss a day, he/she needs to bring a note to the teacher which states the reason for the absence. Absences not documented by a note are considered unexcused.

Unexcused Absences The State of Indiana requires the reporting of unexcused absences. Students who have 10 or more unexcused absences are considered by the State as "habitually truant" and must be reported to the State and other authorities.

Perfect Attendance Students are working really hard each 9 weeks to get a ticket for Perfect Attendance. With this ticket, the students can put their name in for a drawing for several really cool prizes, free popcorn, and they also get to sit at a special table during lunch! Students that are here on time everyday are eligible for perfect attendance.

E-Learning Days will occur on the day of inclement weather. Your child will need to complete all e-learning assignments within 2 days of the e-learning day. If you have any issues or problems you must communicate this to your child's teacher. If your child does not complete the e-learning assignments they will be marked unexcused for attendance for that e-learning day.
