New Student Registration dates for the 2019-2020 School Year will be **August 1st & 2nd**. If you have a child that will be new to Wheatfield Elementary School please come in on one of these dates listed above. You will need to bring in *Birth Certificate, Shot record, and 2 proofs of residency* with you when you register.

Returning Student Registration for next school year will be online again. Information through emails and skyward skylert will be sent out in July for returning students and those pre-registered kindergarten students. Families will be able to register from the comfort of their home, or they can come to school on one of the dates listed above and use a computer.

Lunch Account Balances will not be refunded. They will carry over to next school year. Students in third grade this school year should try to have a zero balance on their lunch accounts at the close of the school year. It will make the transition on the debit system much smoother at the intermediate school.

No Charging The students will not be allowed to charge for lunch during the month of May. Please make sure their account is current and paid in full by the end of the school year.

Report Cards The students' last report card will be available to print out from skyward June 4th. Students need to have all textbooks turned in, all library materials returned, any textbook damage fines paid, and lunch charges paid by the last day of school on May 30th.

Medication Pick Up Some students take medication here at school. If your student has an inhaler or medication leftover, parents need to pick it up before the last day of school.

Class Placement Wheatfield Elementary School has adopted a policy that we do not accept requests for children to be placed in a specific teacher's classroom. It is impossible to find an equitable method to permit requests for a certain teacher. We utilize computer technology as well as other criteria to create class lists.
