Late Start Wednesdays Drop off is at 9:05. Class will begin at 9:20. Like many school teachers across the state, Wheatfield Elementary teachers will participate in professional learning community activities during this time.

School Hours School begins at 8:50 a.m. and students need to be in their classroom by that time. The doors open at 8:35. Students who arrive after 8:50 are considered tardy should be accompanied to the office to be signed in. Dismissal begins at 3:25 p.m.

Office Hours The Wheatfield Elementary School Office is open from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Anytime you come to school, please make sure you stop in the office. Please have your ID with you if you are planning on leaving the office to go to the classroom or lunch.

Criminal Background Checks If you are going to volunteer in our school, be a chaperone for a field trip or help with school events, you will need a criminal background check. A new one must be filled out each school year. Please send a note to your child's teacher and we will send a release form home for you to sign. Thank you for helping!

Immunizations The nurse has several incomplete immunization records. If you have current records for your child, please turn them in to the nurse. If you have questions, please call Mrs. Ward at extension 6104. Thank you for helping us to keep your child's records up to date.

Students Who Do Not Ride The Bus Students who are dropped off by parents should not arrive prior to 8:35. *Children eating breakfast need to be here by at least 8:40 a.m.* Our student drop off is working well! We greatly appreciate the cooperation we have received from parents! Parents are encouraged to use the student drop off, as parking is sometimes limited.

Helpful Hints

1. Have students exit from the passenger side of the vehicle.
2. Students may exit vehicles from any location in the drop off area and walk on the sidewalk to the door.
3. Pull up as far forward as possible to allow those behind you to enter the drop off area.
4. Watch for parents and students walking from parked cars.
5. Please avoid the bus entrance.

Absences Please call the school office to report your child absent. If your child does miss a day, he/she needs to bring a note to the teacher which states the reason for the absence. Absences not documented by a note are considered unexcused.

Unexcused Absences The State of Indiana requires the reporting of unexcused absences. Students who have 10 or more unexcused absences are considered by the State as "habitually truant" and must be reported to the State and other authorities.

Homework Requests For Sick Students If you want the teacher to prepare homework for your child who is not in school, please call the school office by 10:00 a.m. for pickup at the end of the day.
